### *Ron Melton, GWAC Chairman*

## Conference and Event Planning

### ***Ron Melton, GWAC Administrator***

#### **NARUC Meeting**

Ron Melton was invited to participate as a panelist covering Transactive Energy November 17, 2013. Another panelist will be Patty Durand of the SmartGrid Consumer Collaborative, and she will be discussing the new Smart Grid Environmental and Economic Benefits Study. A presenter from Navigant discussing Cloud Energy will attend as well.

#### **Power Industry Transformation Summit**

InfoCast is organizing a Power Industry Transformation Summit on April 1 – 3, 2014 in the Bay area. The goal for the summit is to bring together communities who don't normally interact on the topic of demand energy response. InfoCast contacted Ron Melton and Ed Cazalet and asked for assistance in creating a track on transactive energy. Discussion continued and it was determined that this would be a good venue to socialize the GWAC Transactive Energy Framework. Ron Melton asked for volunteer GWAC members to take the lead on this event.

#### **GWAC March Face-to-Face Planning**

John McDonald from General Electric approached Ron Melton at the November SGIP conference and offered to host a meeting in Atlanta in 2014. Ron Ambrosio offered the IBM meeting space in New York and Ward Camp offered Landis+Gyr in Atlanta. Discussion continued on what regions would be best to evangelize the takeaways from the framework. Paul De Martini

recommended Texas and the northeast region of the US. David Forfia agreed to contact Sue Convino regarding the possibility to host the March 2014 GWAC meeting at PJM facility.

### **GWAC December Face-to-Face Planning**

The GWAC Transactive Energy Framework Workshop and face-to-face meeting will be held December 10-11, 2013 at the Rose Center in Westminster, CA. The workshop will be limited to 50 people and an evening reception immediately following will be hosted by Southern California Edison. Ron Melton discussed the meeting focus, agenda and template. The template to be used was the same template used in creating the Transactive Energy Framework case studies. Presenters will be asked to discuss their project using the attributes defined in the Transactive Energy Framework, fleshed out for their particular approach to transactive energy by using the workshop template.

On December 12, a meeting will be held from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM for Council members focusing on administrative business at the Southern California Edison Advance Technology Lab.

### **Peak Load Management Alliance (PLMA) Conference**

James Mater reported that the overall presentation went well and two participants from the PLMA conference will be attending the GWAC workshop in December.

### **SGIP Conference**

Ron Melton reported that there were four sessions at the SGIP conference that were GWAC or related to transactive energy:

- Home to Grid Domain Expert Working Group (H2G DEWG) Meeting. Ken Wacks reported the group completed work on an important paper called *The Broadcast Communications for Energy Management*.
- Ron Melton and Ward Camp participated in the Business and Policy Domain Expert Domain Working Group (BnP DEWG) Meeting
- Ron Ambrosio led the kick-off meeting for Smart Grid Architecture Committee Transactive Energy (SGAC TE) working party
- Stephan Amsbary led the NIST Roadmap 3.0 Architecture Meeting that did not specifically speak on transactive energy but more on the general architecture considerations

### **Transactive Energy Conference 2014**

The new dates for the 2<sup>nd</sup> International Energy Conference range from December 10-11, 2014. Discussion continued on the possibility of linking a GWAC face-to-face meeting the day prior, December 9, 2014. The meeting will be held at the World Trade Center in Portland, Oregon.

## Transactive Energy Framework

### *Ron Melton, GWAC Administrator*

Ron Melton thanked the GWAC members that participated in the GWAC Transactive Energy Framework draft roll-out at the SGIP meeting. Ward Camp, Ron Ambrosio, Erich Gunther and Ken Wacks participated in the plenary session to introduce the Transactive Energy Framework. Following the plenary session there were three breakout sessions:

- Breakout Session 1: Policy and Regulation was led by Ward Camp and David Forfia
- Breakout Session 2: Business Models and Value Creation was led by Ron Ambrosio and James Mater
- Breakout Session 3: Architecture/Cyber-Physical was led by Ron Ambrosio and Erich Gunther

On November 6, 2013 the Transactive Energy Framework was released, and over all, the framework has been well received and the Council has received good feedback and questions. The Transactive Energy Framework was posted to the GWAC website and the EnergyBiz article on the framework was published.

The Council needs to investigate the best avenues to gather the feedback and comments to enhance the framework.

- Several comments have been posted on the Transactive Energy Association LinkedIn group discussion board
  - Ron Melton stated that the Council is reading and listening to the comments posted
- The Council needs to determine how to productively engage with the broader community to further the framework document

Two suggestions were possibly a FAQ section on the GWAC website and a formal comments form to collect feedback.
